



## Regulated Closure and Restrictions

Effective July 1<sup>st</sup> 12:01 a.m.

When **FIRE SEASON** goes into effect, some activities in the great outdoors are prone to start fires. In an effort to prevent these fires from starting, Lake Chinook Fire & Rescue and our partner, the Oregon Department of Forestry impose restrictions pertaining to public and work related activities on private lands within our districts.

Effective 1201 a.m. Friday July 1<sup>st</sup>, the following land use and fire restriction will be effective in LCF&R protection district .

**OPEN FIRES** are prohibited including: campfires, charcoal fires, cooking fires, warming fires and burn barrels.

**USE OF FIREWORKS** is prohibited. Use of fireworks, **including those approved by the state fire marshal** is prohibited

**NON-INDUSTRIAL CHAINSAW USE** is prohibited between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. In addition, a fire watch is required at least one hour following the use of each saw.

Use of **MOTORIZED VEHICLES** including motorcycles and all-terrain vehicles is prohibited except on improved roads.

**MOWING** of dried and cured grass with power driven equipment is prohibited between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

**CUTTING, GRINDING** and **WELDING** of metal is prohibited between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. Cutting, grinding and welding of metal is permitted at all other hours, if conducted in a cleared area and if a water supply is present.

**BLASTING** is prohibited.

**RECREATIONAL SHOOTING** - Target shooting is only permitted at designated sites and facilities under special use permit issued by the Fire Chief or his designee.

- Designated facilities may be subject to regulated closures during extreme fire danger levels.
- Tracer, armor piercing, steel core, and Teflon ammunitions are prohibited, as is discharging a firearm at any exploding target.

If a valid 2016 Outdoor Burning Permit has been issued, pursuant to ORS 478.960, propane campfire pits / rings are permitted.

**Enforcement:** In accordance LCF&R Ordinance 2010-02 and with provisions of ORS 478.990 (2) and (3), violations of ORS 478.960 (1) and (4) are mis-demeanor violations which carry their own citation schedule. Jefferson County ordinance applicable.
